

2020-2021 HES Graduate Scholarship Application Form – Continuing Students

Starting from the academic year of 2020-2021, the HES Research and Graduate Studies office offers scholarships for continuing graduate students who completed at least their first-year graduate program. However, the recipients must be enrolled full-time in graduate programs during the academic year of 2020-2021 (nine hours of graded graduate course work per semester).

Students must show excellent professional promise through their cutting-edge research. The candidates will be nominated by each department's graduate faculty and HES Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Studies will confirm the awards. The nomination letter must include how the candidate research will make the greatest social impact, as well as the candidate's academic achievement at MU HES. Each department may nominate 1 candidate per year. The award recipient will receive one of the four scholarships described in the next page.

Campbell-Harrison Award

Open to all graduate students in HES, with priority to descendants of alumni of the Campbell-Harrison House. *NOTE: If applicant is a descendent of an alumni of the Campbell-Harrison house, please include description of this relationship with the application. Two awards expected for FY2020. [\$500 each]*

G. Maxene Harris Memorial Fund (Do not apply to SSW students)

One annual award shall be made to graduate students in the Departments of Personal Financial Planning, Architectural Studies, Human Development and Family Studies, Nutritional Sciences, or Textile and Apparel Management. Recipients shall be enrolled in the MU Intensive Writing Program or shall have previously completed the same at MU. Preference shall be given to female students. Selection shall be based solely on merit and academic performance. Recipients are expected to gain additional communication skills through writing for the college news magazine, Vanguard, Extension newsletters, scholarship brochures, or other publications, and would receive a byline as the Maxene Harris Communication Fellow. *One awards expected for FY2020.*

Martin-Quilling Graduate Fellowship in Human Environmental Sciences

Scholarships shall be awarded to full-time graduate students pursuing advanced degrees in the College of Human Environmental Sciences. *Two awards expected for FY2020. [\$500]*

Mary L. Johnson Scholarship

To provide annual scholarship awards to students in the fields of social science, extension service, home economics, communication, or a combination of any of these with other areas of study. Consideration shall also be given to the financial needs of the students, but not as the determining factor. *One scholarship expected for FY 2020. [Estimated \$500]*
