Campbell-Harrison Award

Open to all graduate students in HES, with priority to descendants of alumni of the Campbell-Harrison House. *NOTE: If applicant is a descendent of an alumni of the Campbell-Harrison house, please include description of this relationship with the application.* If the student completed BS or MS in HES and starts her or his master's or doctoral program for the first time in HES, the student is eligible. One award expected for FY2021. [Estimated \$3,500]

Adeline M. Hoffman Fellowship Award

Two-to-three Hoffman Fellowships will be awarded for FY2021. All HES departments are eligible; however, recipients must be *first year graduate students, either MA/MS or PhD levels.* If the student completed BS or MS in HES and starts her or his master's or doctoral program for the first time in HES, the student is eligible. [Estimated \$6,000-\$10,000 each].

Marion K. and Vernon W. Piper Distinguished Doctoral Fellowships (Do not apply to SSW students)

Piper Fellowships are awarded to permit the College of Human Environmental Sciences to compete nationally for the best *new doctoral students.* The student would have to be a new doctoral student for the first time in HES. The student may or may not have completed master's degree in HES. In addition, students shall be pursuing a doctoral degree in one of the following areas: Nutritional Sciences, Architectural Studies, Personal Financial Planning, Textile and Apparel Management, and Human Development and Family Studies. Three-to-four fellowships will be awarded for FY2021. [Estimated \$6,000-10,000 each]

We do not accept applications directly from individual applicants. Any interested students should contact their departmental Director of Graduate Studies.

NOTE: To receive awards, students must be enrolled full-time in masters or doctoral study (nine hours of graded graduate course work per semester, or at least 6 hours if ABD).
